THE RULES

21 Questions Wrong Hotseat is an exciting MULTIPLAYER variant of the popular Avanti Un Altro endgame. Instead of one person trying to get 21 questions wrong in a row against the clock, a group of players play collaboratively but against each other and the clock.

STANDARD RULES

- * It's good to have a prize and one you as quizmaster don't mind giving away, the game is more fun the faster you go.

- * Have a watch with a timer on it. Depending on your friends level of quiz experience set it to go off 6-8 minutes time.

- * Start with player one (you can choose how this is determined) and ask them the first question. If they get it wrong move on to the next question. If they pick the legitimate correct answer, or they take too long to answer (it should be prompt but not necessarily immediate, about 1.5 seconds is TV standard, your mileage may vary) shout either NO! or TIME! and start at question one with the next person in line.

- * Players are free to interrupt.

- * People can have multiple goes if time allows. If your timer goes off then the person currently on a run may continue until they win or fail.

- * Whoever wrongly answers the 21st question is the winner. If nobody manages to run the list you win! Well done.

Here is my spiel, you can adapt it if you like:

"I've got 21 questions, you've got to get them all wrong. Be the one to give me all 21 WRONG answers in the RIGHT order in seven minutes and you win the prize. Make a mistake or don't answer promptly and you lose your turn and I'll start with the next person. After seven minutes your time is up and I win, although a person on a run when the alarm goes can finish their go. Good luck!"
