REVERSE CALENDAR

Starts from the present date, runs toward the past.  
History heads to the bottom of the page.

At least one session/day to check for threats.

- Cue = Document describing alphanumerically, all possible Events. About 50 line items. Current Document is “Cue 5.5”
- Viewer = The person who produces a Session.
- Session = The final product that evokes psychic data. Examples: Structured or Unstructured Psychic/RV, Waking Premonition, Precognitive Dream,...
- Data = Information derived from a Session
- Analysis = Interpretation of the Data, as little as necessary, to have clarity on facts.
- Threat = A Session, its Data, then Analysis, suggests a specific Event listed in the Cue is forthcoming
  - A Threat is an Event that hasn’t occurred yet.
  - Threats are labeled by Julian Date.
  - Threats are broken out into their own calendar section.
- Call = An explicit identified Threat
- Event = An actual occurrence of some importance that occurs in, or effects, our world.
- Warning** = Threat initially identified, arriving within 96 hours.
- Watch** = Threat potential still exists for another 96 hours.
- Energy = Ability to exert force; a spectrum from low to high. Higher energy equates to more destruction, deaths, social-political upheaval, etc....
- 96 hours = This timeframe was established over time as most Events occurred within 4 days.
  - (speculation) That “within 96 hours” is historical, enough time for a tribe, town, city to prepare for earthquake, volcano, tornado, tsunami ....

Possible Results:

- Hit = A called Threat under **Warning** or **Watch** matches an Event.
- Bad Call = A called Threat **Warning-Watch**, expires with no Event.
- Miss = An Event occurs while no Threat was identified.
- Null = No Threat is identified and no Event occurs

In Practice:

A Threat starts immediately as a **Warning**.

If Threat fails to arrive, **Warning** is downgraded to a **Watch**.

**Watch** expires if daily Sessions fail to identify the same Threat again. See “Bad Call.”

**Watch** reverts back to **Warning** if daily Session identifies the same Threat again.

This **Warning** to **Watch** to [same Threat identified in new Session] back to **Warning** cycling extends Threat window. My experience suggests 2 reasons:

1 - The identified Event is of larger Energy than normal.

Why a longer window for larger Energy Events?

A - Give time for more people to become aware (speculation)

B - Give people more time to prepare (speculation)

2 - The identified Event is within close proximity to the Viewer
