

Austin Middle School Families,

The ALSDE is implementing the Alabama Comprehensive Assessment Program or ACAP Summative Assessment for all 2<sup>nd</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> grade students. Students at Austin Middle will take the following assessments: English Language Arts (6<sup>th</sup> – 7<sup>th</sup>), Mathematics (6<sup>th</sup> - 7<sup>th</sup>), and Science (6<sup>th</sup> only). All students are expected to be physically present and, in the building, to test. For accountability measures, we must have 95% of our students tested in ACAP. It is our goal at AMS to have 100% of our students tested. IT IS EXTREMELY IMPORTANT THAT ALL STUDENTS ARE PRESENT ON THEIR TESTING DATES. Please schedule appointments and trips around these testing dates when possible. Also, we *encourage all students to get an appropriate amount of sleep and eat a healthy breakfast*.

We will begin to test each morning at 8:30 a.m. Students should report to school between 7:30-8:20 a.m. each day for testing. During testing, all students should bring the following items to school: fully charged device and computer charger. They should not have electronic devices in the testing room. They will be left outside of the testing room.

- ACAP Science (grade 6 only) on April 14, 2022
- ACAP ELA (grade 6 only) on April 19- April 20, 2022
- ACAP Math (grade 6 only) on April 21, 2022
- ACAP ELA (grade 7 only) on April 26- April 27, 2022
- ACAP Math (grade 7 only) on April 28, 2022
  - \*ACAP Alternative Testing for traditional students will be completed throughout the testing window.
  - \*Make up testing will be completed throughout the testing window. Please plan for adjustments to this testing calendar as necessary.

Again, we are looking forward to a great testing season. We know that all students will try their very best on this assessment.
