ECA ELEMENTARY STUDENT DRESS CODE

All ECA students are required to wear the official school uniform shirt with official school solid navy blue pants shorts or a skirt. Students who choose to wear a sweater in addition to the school shirt **will be required** to wear the official school sweatshirt. No sandals or earrings on boys are allowed.

Descriptions of the two elementary uniforms are below.

Parents will be called to bring appropriate uniform attire for violations of the dress code.

Nursery, Pre-kinder and Kindergarten students:

- Shirt – ECA Red uniform shirt with school logo
- ECA Solid navy blue pants or, shorts or a skirt
- Shoes or sneakers of any color are acceptable; however, closed toe shoes are preferred.

Elementary School Students-Grades 1-5

- Shirt –White uniform shirt with school logo
- Navy blue/black pants, jeans, Bermudas or a skirt
- Shoes or sneakers of any color are acceptable; however, closed toe shoes are preferred.

Footwear – Students should wear proper footwear to school. For their own safety, footwear should cover toes (front) and have a back restraint. Sneakers or tennis shoes are required for physical education, recreation and athletic activities. Flip-flops are not acceptable at any time. Any other deviation from the school uniform must be given prior approval by the ES Principal.

PE Dress Code – On PE days it is important that your child comes to school dressed for physical education. He/she should wear: sneakers and socks; school shirt; navy blue shorts or sweatpants. When classes are scheduled to take place on the field we also recommend that children wear a hat, sunscreen and carry a bottle of water.

For safety reasons jewelry should not be worn to physical education classes and is generally discouraged at any time. **The school will not accept responsibility for missing items.**

ECA SECONDARY SCHOOL DRESS CODE

Observing the dress code is one of the ways that students demonstrate respect and responsibility to the community.

Please note that the Secondary Principal is **ultimately responsible** for defining what is appropriate and not appropriate dress and for enforcing dress code decisions.

From the time students enter campus until they leave, they are required to wear the ECA official school uniform unless they are involved in an athletic event/practice.

Parents will be called to bring in appropriate uniforms if a student is not in the correct uniform and will complete their classes in the secondary office area until they are in the correct uniform.

No cut-off pants, or torn clothing is permitted.

Shirts: ECA issued uniform shirts must be worn at all times.

Sweater, Fleece or Sweatshirt: Only ECA branded hooded sweatshirts will be permitted at school NB: No sweatshirt or fleece/sweater with other logos or advertising (other than ECA) is acceptable.

Shorts: ECA shorts or plain navy blue or black. Shorts should be worn neatly and should be at least mid thigh length. Small logos on shorts, as approved by the Secondary Principal, are permitted. **Beachwear shorts are not acceptable.**

Pants: ECA pants or plain navy blue/black pants or **plain** blue jeans

Skirts: Plain Navy blue/black or blue jean skirt (NB: should be at least mid thigh length - NB: no logos, advertising, holes, rips or tears).

Plain Leggings/Joggings/Sweatpants: Plain Navy blue/black. (Full length or capri/crop length are suitable).

Footwear: Traditional black or brown shoes, trainers are permitted. No sandals, crocs and slides.

Special Notes:

1. The correct ECA physical education uniform is required for students in grades 6-10.
2. Hats may be worn on campus but **not in classrooms or in the Theater.**
3. Earrings, one necklace, and one bracelet are permitted. Nose piercings and excessive jewelry will be asked to be removed.
4. Jewelry is not permitted in P.E. classes.
5. The Secondary Principal will decide when those Senior students, who are in good standing, can be awarded Senior Dress-code and any other special privileges.
