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Salk Pre-Engineering STEM Magnet Middle School Named A Top 2024 Magnet School of Excellence by Magnet Schools of America

Salk Middle School has been named one of the top 2024 Magnet Schools of Excellence by Magnet Schools of America, the national association for magnet and theme-based schools.

“This award highlights our staff working collectively to bring STEM and real world applications to all students. Problem-solving, critical thinking, creativity, and collaboration are important STEM skills that our magnet students develop while here at Salk,” principal Dan Wrobleski said. Salk STEM centers their curriculum around three STEM themes, and integrates the Science and Engineering Practices in all classroom content areas. Additional value-added programming includes STEM Days, STEM Career Lunches, GEMS club, National History Day, Science Fair, and STEM Field Experiences in the community.

Salk Middle School will be recognized and receive a National Magnet School of Excellence Merit Award during an awards ceremony held during Magnet Schools of America's National Conference on April 16-20, 2024, in New York City.

Merit School of Excellence Awards are only given to a select group of magnet schools. Schools of Excellence are eligible to receive monetary awards and are eligible to be named the nation's top Elementary, Secondary, or New & Emerging Magnet School. One of the Schools of Excellence will also be selected to win \$5,000 and the Dr. Ronald P. Simpson Distinguished Merit Award, which is considered the most prestigious magnet school award in the nation.

To receive a national merit award, members of Magnet Schools of America must submit a detailed application that is scored by a panel of educators. These schools are judged and scored on their demonstrated ability to raise student academic achievement, promote racial and socioeconomic diversity, provide integrated curricula and instruction, and create strong family and community partnerships that enhance the school's magnet theme.
