#### YOU HAVE 10 TOTAL DRAWINGS DUE BY THE END OF THE YEAR.

You will be expected to turn in one quality art piece every month. It is expected that you spend quality time on the homework assignments. Do not wait until the day before it is due to start your drawings.

## **Expectations:**

- A value range of at least five gradations throughout the entire drawing. Every drawing **must include a 5 step value chart** on the bottom of the page.
- 1 3 4 5
- All drawings should have a background. No floating objects.
   Only 25% of the page should be white. Consider the entire page.
- Allow your imagery to **extend beyond the edges** of the page.
- Pay attention to your **craftsmanship**, **detail and refinement**. Take your drawing to a finished state.
- Sketchbooks must be between 8.5x11 and 9x12.
- <u>Pencil only (first semester)</u>.
- Each drawing must be **labeled on the BACK**. (Name, Date, Class section, Description from below, Title)

Homework will be collected at the beginning of class on the day it is due. I will collect your entire sketchbook in order to see the progression of your drawing.

Late work will be deducted 3 points for each day that it is late. Any day that school is in session is a day late, unless you have an excused absence.
