## Renewal of Vows

**PRIEST** I invite you now to recall the vows that you made at your wedding.

*Husband and wife face each other and hold hands.*

**HUSBAND** I, N, took you, N, to be my wife;

**WIFE** I, N, took you, N, to be my husband;

**COUPLE** to have and to hold from that day forward, for better, for worse, for richer, for poorer, in sickness and in health, to love and to cherish, till death us do part, according to God's holy law, and this was our solemn vow.

Today, in the presence of our family and friends, we affirm our continuing commitment to this vow.

*The priest says to the congregation:*

Will you, the family and friends of N and N continue to support and uphold them in their marriage now and in the years to come?

**ALL** **We will.**

## The Rings

*Touching one another's rings, the husband and wife say:*

I gave you this ring as a sign of our marriage.  
With my body I honour you,  
all that I am I give to you,  
and all that I have I share with you,

within the love of God,  
Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

*The priest blesses the couple, to which all respond*

**Amen.**

## **Prayers**

*The priest reads the prayers, to which all respond*

**Amen.**

*The priest introduces the Lord's Prayer, and all say*

**Our Father, who art in heaven,  
hallowed be thy name;  
thy kingdom come;  
thy will be done;  
on earth as it is in heaven.  
Give us this day our daily bread.  
And forgive us our trespasses,  
as we forgive those who trespass against us.  
And lead us not into temptation;  
but deliver us from evil.  
For thine is the kingdom,  
the power and the glory,  
for ever and ever.  
Amen.**
