Every summer, SRL brings new teachers to Washington DC for an intensive and fun professional development workshop that has been described as "the best education professional development ever had."

During the 3-day Workshop you will:

- Learn how to start the school year strong by effectively communicating the purpose and goals of SRL.
- Explore the SRL curriculum, timelines and expectations with your peers and experienced instructors.
- Share best practices and ideas for classroom management.
- Learn how to get buy-in from your principal, school administration and local media.
- Meet your next best friends and colleagues in the field.
- Come away inspired, energized and brimming with ideas for the coming year!

We will also work to align your goals to those of the SRL program:

- Help students find their voices through a range of participation.
- Tell stories with a unique youth perspectives that show how your students and community are grappling with newsworthy events and real world problems.
- Connect your classroom to the rest of the world through your local PBS station, the PBS NewsHour, inspiring mentors and career education opportunities.
