

Guide to Writing in Applied Industrial Technology and Management Journals

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ABSTRACT

This article illustrates the preparation of your paper using MS Word. Papers should not be numbered. The manuscript should be written in English. The length of the manuscript should not exceed 12 pages in this format using A4 single-sided paper. The title page should include the succinct title, the authors, and an abstract of around 200 words at the beginning of the manuscript. The affiliation, address, zip code, and telephone and fax numbers, as well as e-mail address, should be listed below the author's names. The paper begins with a title which uses 14pt Times New Roman.. This is followed by the details for each author in 11pt Times New Roman. Section titles are bolded in 11pt Times New Roman. The remainder of the paper should be typed in 10pt Times New Roman. Please set your margin before you type your article by looking at the page setup of this template. If you have any questions on the format, please send a message to admin@jurnal-tmit.com.

Keywords: Up to six keywords should also be included.

Introduction

The easiest way to write your paper to fit the writing format of the Journal of Technology and Applied Industrial Management is to *copy-paste* your paper into this *template*. This *template* will be provided to you by the editors of the Journal of Applied Industrial Technology and Management if your paper is declared to be publishable in the Journal of Applied Industrial Technology and Management, whether revised or not. The writing of foreign terms should be written in *italics*. The *page setup* for the Journal of Technology and Applied Industrial Management is Top and Left = 2.54 cm, Bottom and Right = 2.54 cm, Gutter = 0 cm. The orientation is Portrait with a Mirror margin. The paper size is A4 with Width = 21 cm and Height = 29.7 cm. The layout is different, odd and even with Header = 1.27 cm and Footer = 1.27 cm. The vertical alignment is Top. (Note: The decimal writing rules above are adapted to the writing rules in *Microsoft Word* that use "." as a decimal sign instead of ",". The decimal writing rules in the Journal of Technology and Applied Industrial Management follow the rules of mathematical writing.

Research Methods

In this guide, we will explain about writing *headings*. If your *heading* exceeds one, use the second level of the heading as below.

Second-Level Heading

The *heading* at the second level is written in *boldface italics* using uppercase and lowercase letters. The *heading* is written on the left.

Third-Level Heading

Heading at the third level follows the style of the second-level heading. Avoid using *headings* of more than three levels.

Results and discussion

Follow the rules of publication in this journal, which are: 1. Introduction, 2. Research Methods, 3. Results and Discussion, 4. Conclusion.

Writing Mathematical Equations

Mathematical equations should be numbered sequentially and start with (1) to the end of the paper, including the appendix. This numbering must begin and end with open brackets and close brackets, and be right-aligned. Add one blank line above and below the equation. The size of the equation is Full 11pt, Subscript/superscript 8pt, Sub-Subscript/superscript 6pt, Symbol 12 pt, Sup-symbol 10 pt. Insert equations to write math equations with *math style*.

$$f(t) = \int_0^t F(u) du + \frac{dg(t)}{dt} \quad (1)$$

All variable writing is written in *italics* with numerical indexes in *Times New Roman*, for example. $X_1, \dots, X_n Y_i, i = 1, \dots, n$. Use the sign " : " to explain the meaning of the variable and "=" if the variable is worth a number or equation. N : amount of data. The writing of decimal numbers is separated by the comma "," and if more than one use the semicolon ";", as a separator, for example (0.234; 123,135; 4562,234). All $X = 1$ *Parentheses* are written with the letters Century Schoolbook, $[(X_1, X_2) i]$.

Figures and Tables

Each image must be captioned under the image. The description in the table is given above the table. Descriptions are written in lowercase letters except for the first character of each sentence. All images should be numbered sequentially. The image is placed in the center of the page (*center alignment*), while the table starts at the left edge of the page.

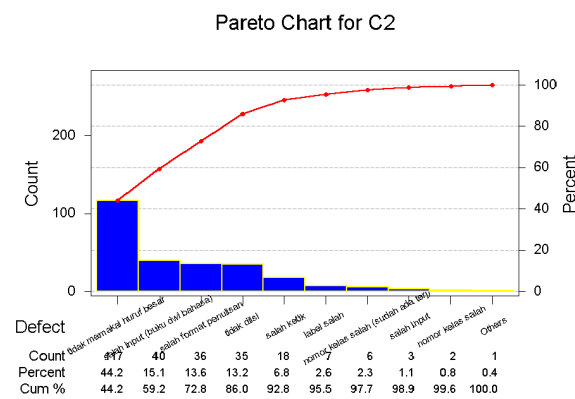


Figure 1. Use capital letters only at the beginning of the image name without the end of the period

Image 1: The caption on the image should be visible below the image. References that use pictures, tables, theorems, or lemmas must begin with capital letters without a separating period, for example, **Figure 1** and **Table 1** are illustrations of Theorem 1. All accompanying captions are written in capital letters at the beginning only. Tables and pictures should be placed inside *Body Text* and meet the standards for printing. The picture does not need to be framed.
The caption on the table should be visible above the table.

Write the conclusion of your paper in the form of a narrative and not in the form of *bullets* or *numerals*.

Reference Reference

It is recommended to use Mendeley's tools for referral management. Everything listed in the bibliography/references must be referenced in the manuscript. **Minimum of 25 primary and recent references (last 5 years)**. References should use the **IEEE reference style** and use the app **Mendeley**. Write down the references used in the main paper. Don't include references that have never been used as a reference in writing a script. The reference writing style is given below. [1]–[3]) or [4], [5] or [6]
