CONTENT EXCERPT #1

"It wasn't only that I was hurting others, we were hurting others, but I was hurting me, they were hurting me. My scale became my drug. Food, my poison. A treadmill, my home."

CONTENT EXCERPT #2

"It was sickening to think of the things they taught us, but I was prey to their lessons because it was also sickening to fathom eating more than 1300 calories a day. Hailey didn't know that the night before I had succumbed to the terrors of modelhood."

CONTENT EXCERPT #3

"I still have bulimia. It doesn't just fade like a bad memory, it wasn't a one time craze like a juice fast or that keto diet I tried in 2014. CONTENT EXCERPT #1

RAYA

(RAYA kneels beside him and checks his pulse.)

RAYA

Do you think that's possible? I think we should tell someone.

(RAYA grabs SAMANTHA's phone.)

RAYA

CONTENT EXCERPT #2

Yeah but like, I don't really feel like going to prison, and I look really bad in orange. Plus, I hate jumpsuits.

(TITO enters from stage right as SAMANTHA is talking, eventually positioning himself in the middle of the two girls.)

SAMANTHA

They're so out of style and you have to get fully naked just to pee.

TITO

I just got here and you guys are already talking about getting naked and pissing? Damn, you guys really know how to party.

CONTENT EXCERPT #3

TITO

Nah, I told you, he'll be fine. He's probably already awake and calling somebody to pick him up as we speak.

RAYA

No, T, Rob is like actually deceased. Samantha killed him because she was too good at sex.

TITO

(still laughing) I don't know, man, I guess I'm just too pumped up on adrenaline after my performance to care. Did you say Samantha killed him because she was too good at sex?



It's not funny. How do you think I feel? I'm so hot that someone died because of me! (getting emotional) My existence is just like, detrimental to everyone's health.

RAYA

It's okay, Samantha. It's not your fault that you were born this way. The open-mic place is on the way to the gas station so we can pick you up some cigarettes if you want.

SAMANTHA

(in tears) I don't even smoke cigarettes, I just have them so that I can light them and look hot and offer them to boys. But what's even the point if I can't have sex without killing them?
