### Instructions:

-For a Memorial, select template "Bill 2" when registering for Session in Regy

-Fill in the "title" (optional) and "body" areas below with your bill's language

-Replace red text with your own, and remove any unnecessary pre-populated text.

-All black text in the body section is standard for Memorials, don't remove or alter it (unless you don't need that many WHEREAS statements).

-Font: Verdana, Size: 10, Black

-Copy and paste title and body areas only into the appropriate sections on the Regy Bill 2 template.

-In Regy, the standard text "TO THE HONORABLE..." is automatically included in your bill when you use the Bill 2 template.

-Include the "We, Your Memorialists," "WHEREAS," "NOW THEREFORE" and "BE IT RESOLVED" portions of the body section.

Body:	<p>We, Your Memorialists, the Senate and House of Representatives of the YMCA Youth Legislature of the State of Washington, in legislative session assembled, respectfully represent and petition as follows:</p> <p>WHEREAS, (include supporting facts of your Memorial), and</p> <p>WHEREAS, (you'll likely have multiple WHEREAS clauses), and</p> <p>WHEREAS, (this final WHEREAS ends just with a comma, not the word "and"),</p> <p>NOW, THEREFORE, We, your Memorialists, respectfully request (include what action you are specifically requesting).</p> <p>BE IT RESOLVED, That copies of the Memorial be immediately sent to the Honorable Joseph Biden, President of the United States, the President of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and each member of Congress from the State of Washington.</p>
