Notes

- Types of licensing in Eclipse Foundation
 - Type A
 - Created primarily in response to Node/NPM
 - Less stringent analysis due to the fact that Node deps can change without notification
 - Theia has started with Type A
 - Che uses this for JS deps
 - Type B
 - This is more stringent
 - May impact time needed to get CQs passed (takes longer)
 - Che has used Type B so far
 - Typically projects have to be either Type B or A
 - Question: can we do interim releases as Type A then do a major release as Type B?
 - It appears so
 - It also seems we can have a branch for Type B and a faster-moving branch for Type A
 - Although this gets heavy to manage and introduce new contributors to
 - **Brad to sync with Gorkem / Max on this question**
- Workspace.next
 - Sergii sent a note to che-dev outlining issues for workspace.next
 - Work is starting soon on registry and infrastructure implementation
 - First release will focus on Openshift and K8s, Docker will follow
 - Guy (SAP): Is this part of Che 6 or Che 7?

- Sergii - will bring it into Che 6 as optional beta feature - allows to test with che 6 without risking and impacting 6. In Che 7 this will be the default.
- Goal is to maintain the current model from Che 6 as we move forward, new features will be done as new objects
- Guy: We are using Che 6 behind Che 3 so having the API stability is critical
- Eugene: goal is to get started as quickly as possible, but this will take some time. Attributes and feature description will be translated into a new environment.
- Guy: do you see that there will be any differences in features of workspace.next based on the implementation (OS vs. k8s)?
- Sergii expects no major differences, goal is to keep things as much as possible at the common k8s layer
- Eugene - harder to say for Docker, more likely to affect features
