SEIU Local 221 negotiated an MOU with the Fallbrook Union High School District that ensures:

- Employees will continue to receive their regular pay during school closure.
- FUHSD will work to ensure safe working conditions that follow guidelines of California Department of Public Health.
- FUHSD will pay absence pay for family care
- FUHSD guidelines on verification of illness will take into account the impact on healthcare providers.

Local 221 also won 10%-20% hazard pay differentials for San Diego Housing Commission employees who work in person during the "Stay at Home" order. It also provides \$80-\$100 per month to each employee working from home to help cover their remote work costs.
