December 13, 2017 Board Minutes

The regular board meeting of the HLV Community School District was held on December 13, 2017, at 5:00 p.m. President Hollopeter called the meeting to order.

Hawkins motioned to approve the bid for replacement of windows in the elementary, seconded Doran, unanimously adopted.

Under the Superintendent's report, Hohensee presented his December schedule. Hohensee discussed the IASB Conference. The Area School Board Inservice will be held January 25th at the Michael J. Manatt Community Center. Hohensee congratulated the kitchen staff for a job well done with the inspection. A rally will be held at the State Capital supporting public education on January 30, 2018.
