1. General information

- Westminster High School PTSA will be awarding 3-5 academic scholarships at the end of the school year. Awards will be made in late May - early June.
- Scholarships are one-time only and not renewable.
- Scholarships will be awarded based on ability, need, student engagement, volunteerism, and/or academic performance.
- Scholarship recipients will be selected by a panel made up of both PTSA board members and Westminster High School staff.

2. Eligibility criteria

- Must be a graduating Westminster High School senior that is planning to continue their education at a four-year college or university, community college, technical school, or vocational school.
- Must have attended Westminster High School for at least one full academic year.

3. Scholarship award

- Scholarships will be in the amount of \$500 each.

4. Submission and due date

- Submit a folder with your completed application, one letter of recommendation, and one essay (no more than 600 words) to Trees Hill, Community Resource Coordinator in The Well by **Friday, March 13, 2026**.
