

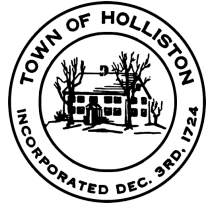


# Holliston Police Department Junior Police Academy

# Holliston Junior Police Academy

## Code of Conduct

The instructors at the Holliston Junior Police Academy are dedicated to providing a fun, safe and educational summer program for our cadets. To help us accomplish this goal, cadets will be held to a high standard and are expected to behave appropriately. We ask that all cadets and parents/guardians read this code together before arriving at camp.

As a cadet,

Respect:

- I will be responsible for my words and actions and be respectful to other cadets
- I will be respectful to instructors and guest speakers
- I will be polite and courteous during presentations and classroom activities
- I will treat others the way I want to be treated
- I will use the camp equipment and facilities appropriately and responsibly

Behavior:

- I understand that horseplay, inappropriate touching, unwelcome teasing/bullying or any unkind behavior will not be tolerated
- I will communicate in an appropriate manner, which means no foul language, gestures or harsh words
- I understand that pushing, kicking, hitting or fighting are not acceptable behaviors
- I understand that if I am a continual disruption to the learning environment, I could be disciplined, including but not limited to removal of camp for the day or the entirety of the week
- I know that cell phones are only to be used for emergencies

Safety:

- I shall follow the directions of the Instructors and or any of the guest speakers who attend
- I must inform the Instructors if I am experiencing a problem with another cadet or any other issues. If an Instructor is not informed about a problem, they cannot assist or stop the problem
- I understand that weapons, including pocket knives, or any look-alike weapons shall not be brought to camp
- If there are any emergencies, I must report them immediately to an Instructor

Violation of the Code of Conduct can be grounds for disciplinary actions including but not limited to automatic removal from the camp.

I have read the above Code of Conduct. I agree to adhere to all the above to ensure that my camp experience and the experience of other cadets is a positive one. I understand that failure to adhere to these rules may result in dismissal from the camp.
