Use this guide and your notes, handouts, and assignments from class to prepare and study for the first Spanish quiz **on Wednesday 9/17.** This quiz will <u>not</u> be open note and spelling counts.

- The alphabet. Be prepared to recognize letters when they are said aloud and spell out words on paper.
 - o Example: "e-ese-ce-ere-i-be-e" spells escribe.
 - You may practice listening to the letters with the two videos at the bottom of the "Videos & Resources" page on the Homework Hub. Try also spelling words aloud yourself.
- Classroom vocabulary and gender of nouns and articles. Be prepared to identify and spell
 classroom vocabulary words correctly as well as the masculine or feminine articles el or la.
 - o Examples: la mesa, el lápiz, el marcador, la silla
- Colors. Be prepared to identify and spell the names of colors correctly.
 - o More than one answer may be acceptable for certain colors, i.e. *marrón* or *café*.
 - Don't forget rosado and morado which we added to the handout
 - o There is also a video on colors on the Homework Hub.
- Introductions and greetings. Be prepared to translate and write basic phrases and questions used in introductory conversations. Pay attention to spelling and punctuation.
 - Examples (not a complete list):
 - My name is Fred. → Me llamo Fred.
 - Where are you from? \rightarrow ¿De dónde eres?
 - Good afternoon! → ¡Buenas tardes!
 - Nice to meet you. → Mucho gusto.
- Communicating in class. Be prepared to translate basic phrases and questions used in class.
 - Examples (not a complete list):
 - How do you say squirrel? → ¿Cómo se dice squirrel?
 - What does *el cobayo* mean? → ¿Qué significa *el cobayo*?
- Subject pronouns. Be prepared to identify subject pronouns in a sentence and conjugate verbs accordingly.
 - Examples (not a complete list): <u>Nosotros</u> somos de Chile. <u>Ella</u> es profesora. <u>Ellos</u> son artistas.
- Conjugations of the verb ser. Be able to identify subject pronouns in a sentence and conjugate the verb ser (to be) accordingly.
 - Examples: Nosotros <u>somos</u> estudiantes. Féde y Margarita <u>son</u> amigos. Yo <u>soy</u> de Bolivia.
