Create a questionnaire and gather data about the perfect night in from your family and/or friends. Consider the entertainment, dinner, snacks and drinks. You could present as a graph.



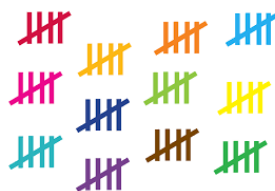
NUMBER FACTS

Follow a recipe and weigh each ingredient using scales. Add the cooking time to the current time to work out when it will be ready. Bon appétit!



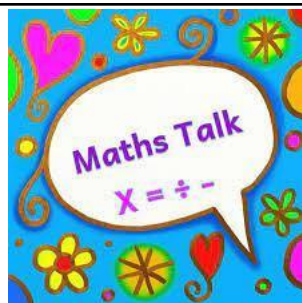
HIT THE BIUTTON

Which area of maths do you think is the most important for everyday life? Discuss with the people at home. Create a poster or Google Slide to explain the reasons.



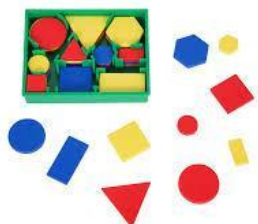
TIMES TABLE TENNIS
