work for you. Before making the last payment, ensure that the work has been successfully completed and that you're content with it. For tax purposes, keep a written record of all transactions and pay by credit card or any form of payment that may leave you with a receipt and proof of payment.

When you begin to receive bids on your project, avoid coming to the conclusion that a low quote will indicate shoddy work. Compare the price of the materials with the low quote, once you have discovered the cost. Additionally, be aware of any labor costs when you're looking at bids. You need to make sure that you only draw up a contract if the pricing is reasonable.
