Principal's Pen

Happy Mothers' day to all the wonderful moms at MES. On Behalf of all the children, thank you for all the love you pour into them. I attended the MES musical yesterday called "Aladdin Jr." Wow, can our MES kids sing and dance! The production was the best I have ever seen in my 30-year career. Thank you to all parent leaders, especially Melissa Solano and Alicia Peak.

On Friday your child brought home the MES Site Council Parent Election Ballot / May, 2022. If you missed it, here it is for you to print out and hand deliver to Diane Sullivan in the office: Link. Thank you for voting.

The Instructional Aide giving drive brought in \$10,391 in two weeks!. At this point 50% of families have donated something. Thank you. As of 5/6/2022 our PTA has generated \$123,538.03 toward our goal of \$220,000. **MES** is the only SMMUSD school that still has not raised enough funds to retain all of our four (4) Instructional Assistants for the 2022-2023 school year. Can we close the gap? Yes, please support the Jog-a-Thon or write a tax deductible donation check to our PTA. We can do this! (Please read the PTA Newsletters for the most thorough details.)

Last week our onsite Covid testing found NO positive cases inside the school. So great! Here is the MES Modified Quarantine calendar to help us stay on the same page: <u>MES - Exposed Classes On-Campus Quarantine</u>

There are two vacant two-year seats for parents on our (2022-2023 & 2023-2024) School Site Council. One parent has self-nominated: Amora Magna. A paper ballot was sent to parents on Friday, May 6. (Also available in the office.) Polls will be open Friday, May 6, and closes Friday, May 27. Election results will be published on Monday, May 30.

Our annual State exams are going well. Our 3rd - 5th graders have completed both the ELA and Math exams and this week, our 5th graders turn their attention to Science Exams. This is a great opportunity for our students to "show what they know". I think they will impress us!

Contractors are busy at school replacing our public address system. Other contractors have measured the blacktop for complete replacement this summer. I cannot wait to see it when it's done!

School Site Council Successes

Many thanks to our MES School Site Council. This team of parents and staff identified environmental, academic, and safety goals for our school. Below are samples of their accomplishments:

Positive Environment: What a fun year it has been for our children! Weekly assemblies, recognition events, spirit days, and lessons on friendship and bully prevention are a sampling of the activities our SSC called for.

Academic Achievement: 67% of our 2021-2022 3rd grade cohort are "at or above standard" as measured by aRead. This group has been nicknamed the "Woolsey Kindergarteners". They are a focus group for MES. In 1st grade only 39% of this group was "at standard" and none were "above". We are making progress! As of January 2022, 3rd - 5th Grade Cohorts % of students "at or above benchmark" as measured by aMath. Was outstanding:

3rd: 97% (Jan 22) 4th: 90% (Jan 22) 5th: 79% (Jan 22)

Safety Achievements: Our Safety Plan was revised. Goals were established. The mold is gone in room 12. The handball courts were replaced. The blacktop is scheduled for replacement. Storm drains have been cleared. Slip hazards have been remediated.

Soon the SSC will finalize new environmental goals and academic goals. I will update you all next week. Next year the SSC will revisit the Safe School Plan and assess our successes or short-comings. You will be kept current.

Safe Arrival and Departure Plan

Before the pandemic and all the social distancing, the Safe Arrival and Departure Plan called for one staff member to man the Grayfox gate. With Covid distancing, we brought teachers to this gate to help with distancing. This school year we have had a lot of missing staff and we were taxed to provide valet services. We have been short an IA the past three weeks too. While I continue to worry we won't have staff next year (Fewer IA's), I will be the new gate monitor at Grayfox beginning May 16. There will be no valet. If I am absent, it is closed.

Grayfox Gate Reopens - No Valet Services

Beginning May 16 I will reopen the Grayfox gate. I will man the gate myself. There will be no valet. Rather parents will park and greet their child on the sidewalk or blacktop. As you can imagine I am bracing the community for the future when we will not have as many Aides as our school once did. With few or no

Aides, the teachers will have to supervise the recess and main gate. I would be the only one to cover Grayfox.

I feel this is the best solution under the circumstances.
