Packing List

For the Room - Each person will have a twin bed with an XL size mattress. Regular twin sheets will NOT fit. Check out the college sales at local stores if you need a set.



You will need:

- Sheets
- pillow(s)
- blanket(s) (rooms have EXCELLENT air conditioning)
- towels (two sets if you like DRY towels in the morning!)
- wash cloths
- a bath mat (shower curtains are provided, but you'll want something to step on)
- tissues
- hand soap
- a garbage bag

You might want to bring your own:

- Snacks (breakfast, lunch, and dinner are provided)
- Drinks (remember, Shippensburg is a dry campus no alcohol is permitted)

Please note: there are NO refrigerators/microwaves in the dorms.

Dress - During the day, dress is casual. Rooms are air conditioned, so you might need a sweater or light jacket. Special evening events are planned; you may wish to bring nicer summer attire for those evenings, but nothing too fancy. We will have one evening at a winery, which has a Rock-n-Roll theme and a prize will be given for trivia winners as well as best themed costume - any decade goes! Bring your shades and favorite rock-n-roll t-shirt and be prepared for a photo booth. There will be some walking to/from the various areas, so comfortable shoes are suggested.

Winery Trip and Other "Events" - You might want to bring some extra cash with you for the winery night and any other "events" for tips, night at a bar, etc..

Equipment - Please bring an internet-capable device to use throughout the summit. This may include a laptop, iPad or tablet, Chromebook etc. There is wifi in rooms throughout the summit.

- Power cords Recharge all devices at night.
- Alarm clock- We rise early and start on-time every day!
- Travel Coffee Container Make sure it is marked with your name.
- Water bottle /canteen It will be hot. Stay cool.
- Small electrical strip Charge your devices in your room overnight
- Lighting- The only lighting in the room is the main overhead lighting, so bring a desk lamp or bedside lamp if you'd like.

Some other suggestions: Umbrella, extra toilet paper (especially if you have a preferred brand!), hangers, Command Hook or over the door hook to hang towel(s) to dry, backpack for carrying things, etc. Remember, college may have been the best years of your life, but you're a little older now, and your body is used to the luxuries that a steady paycheck can provide.
