I am aware that it is a privilege to be accepted into an off-campus course. These courses are meant to provide opportunities to enhance student learning and provide a venue for students to explore alternate learner and career pathways. GENERAL INFORMATION

We offer both introductory and intermediate level welding courses for students through our Lakeland/BTPS partnership. Through participation in these courses, students build skills in welding, even with no experience in the trade.

The course is twenty five hours long with both theory and in lab, practical applications. In the theory portion, the students learn the personnel safety and welding safety guidelines. The practical component includes learning how to use industry hand and power tools, how to use oxy/fuel equipment safely and simple shield metal arc and gas metal arc welding techniques. Students must take Level 1 to qualify for admittance into Level 2.

With this hands-on learning experience, students will gain an understanding of what it takes to work in the welding industry.

COURSE HOURS

The classrooms at Lakeland open at 8:15 and classes begin at 8:30 a.m. sharp. Class runs until 12:00 (noon), and students are given a half hour break for lunch with class resuming at 12:30 and ending at 3:30 p.m. In the case of a condensed week or the need to alter the schedule, class times might change to 8:30 a.m. and run until 4:00 p.m. each day. (the instructor will further inform students)

OTHER USEFUL INFORMATION

- Students are required to wear appropriate clothing; coveralls, steel-toed safety boots and safety goggles for mechanics, electrical, carpentry and welding courses.
- Students are welcome to eat at the Lakeland cafeteria, but should be warned that it is very busy during the lunch hour and students may not have time to order and eat food and be back in class by 12:30. It is recommended that students bring lunch.
- On the first day of classes, students meet in "the pit" in the Trades Centre (if not otherwise directed). Reception and or Lakeland students will be able to direct students to this location.
- Parking is available for students on the southeast side of the Trades building.
- Binders containing welding manuals for students will be housed at Lakeland College's Vermilion campus.
