Old Business-Report Updates

- President Bulger's 11/08 Memo:
 - E Nawabi Shows <u>Drafted Response</u> to group; highlights changes
 - Questions, Comments, and Concerns
 - S Turner appreciates changes made, but still questions process portion of letter; ultimately will not approve because of that; some 'ticky tacky' items listed as needing changes
 - C Joyce relays that Dr Bulger's letter is norm in COlleges; will not approve
 - J Alvardo agrees with S Turner on parallelism in voice; how it is addressed; recommends prompting "this is our reflection" on the process portion
 - K Rivera recommends how to remedy voice;
 - E Nawabi asks for thoughts on process section of memo

- B Crook agrees this Shane, better without Process section
- E Nawabi asks for clarification
- S Turner-What outcome do we want as Council? Thinks a meeting may be a better way to address this section. Does not disagree with the substance of the section.
- K Rivera views the section as documenting efforts to develop working relationship and is important
- S Turner does not preclude that, what is the best way to get there
- J Alvarado inquires about length of process statement
- E Nawabi responds; J Alrado is there flexibility
- B Crook views process section is a second topic; save other feedback for another memo
- E Nawabi disagrees-process section integral; elaborates why; meaningless without that section
- B Crooks asks in chat "Objection to Resolution 3 or is it about the process of decision making"
- K Rivera speaks to her confusion and recaps E Nawabi thoughts; need to be combined to capture complexity
- A Old Coyote does not view confrontation as pejorative; is discomfort with Process word?
- W Burks-document or it didn't happen; in her experience, Dr Bulger wants specifics; views as introducing difficult conversations, not an attack
- S Daniel recommends adding language to beginning—what the purpose is;
- J Alvarado agrees with S Daniel
- W. Burks adds that Dr Bulger is new; may appreciate learning more context at Lane
- E Nawabi address B Crooks earlier question;
 - Does this need more revision?
- S Turner revision will not change for him; questions DC motivation; addressed to all, not just Dr Bulger
- E Nawabi says DC has tried to get these items answered
- K Rivera all involved is what we want; common to address all in organizational communication
- S Daniel ask process question
- R Knighten nots in chat that already past date; agrees about addressing to all

- DEI Officer and Annual Planning DEI Office Goals:

- EN: DEI position would be Vice Chair of Diversity Council; C Joyce is appointed as temp
- EN: expand Strategic Plan goal #1 to include more representation in diversity of staff and faculty and administration

- K Rivera wants position to be internally focused
- C Joyce agrees about internal focus; but adds ECC is a valuable external network; wants position involved with also with MCC and GEC
- E Nawabi understands limited resources; but a good first step; recommends experience in assessment; be up to date with scholarship and changes in field
- A Old Coyote speaks to important Tribal Liaison position, unsure how it should be related to DEI office; wants discussion about separate office for DEI; like an Ombudsman, be thinking about structure
- J Alvarado concerns about that Admin being "at-will" employee; "contract with protection?
- L Soriano speaks to school district practices with administrative hiring
- K Rivera wants student input
- W Burks asks if they could report to Board
- S Turner thinks that statutorily, only president can report to BOE; thanks all for input; reminds people about survey; tells those interested in being on search to contact Celia proactively
