

ROLE DESCRIPTION

Local Organizer

TYPE: Volunteer, ~ 8-10 hrs/wk LOCATION: United States, anywhere

SUMMARY

Local Organizers will help get party messaging onto the ground, working with other Local Organizers from across the nation to execute similar projects, themes, and more where needed. Local Organizers will join national calls at least once a month, but should focus on building a ground team of at least five people who can do things like flyer, recruit, organize, and more.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Local Organizers are the on-the-ground hands of the Progressive Party. They will work with National Distributed Organizers to build in-person groups of people who can host events, flyer, do recruitment exercises, and more. **This role will not be filled until November 10, at the earliest.**

Build groups of people to spread the word about the Progressive Party **Foster** relationships with potential candidates and other organizations in local communities **Organize** events to engage the community in Progressive Party activities and spread the party's message

Examples: flyering at a community fair/protest/farmers market/etc, holding a town hall, etc

Direct potential candidates to the You Can Run infrastructure **Communicate** with National Distributed Organizers in calls at least once a month **Communicate** with potential voters about party stances and community benefits **Coordinate** with National Organizers to implement national party programs in local communities and utilize reach of national party to organize local people

QUALIFICATIONS

- Proficiency in Google Workspace
- High school diploma
- Ability to communicate well with others
- Ownership of a personal computer
- Ability to join online meetings with audio/video
- Strong intrinsic motivation



NOTES

This is a management position. You'll be responsible for *starting and overseeing projects*, so being a self-starter is a requirement.
