Instructions for Canva.com

1.) Go to Cawa benjowering the world to design and login with your Google account.



3.) Choose a **template** or create your own custom page from scratch. (Be sure to only use free layouts, elements, text, and backgrounds. You can upload images not available in Canva by following the prompts on the upload screen.)



- 4.) Include the web address for any images that you use.
- 5.) Cite the sources that you used at the bottom of the infographic in MLA format.
- 6.) When you are finished, click and copy the link to share with your teacher.
- 7.) Print out a copy of the infographic. **Download** \rightarrow **File Type** \rightarrow **PNG**.

Excellent infographics should:

- Start with a clever title
- Keep it simple
- Focus on only what you need to cover
- Honor the infographic (Present the INFORmation in a GRAPHIC way)
- Include facts from credible sources
- Cite your information and pictures
