This week, School Advisory Board member Alex Shelley, Director of Parish Maintenance Abelardo Mendoza, and I met with Kaitlyn Wetzel, Director of Security for the Archdiocese of Chicago, to review and strengthen our school safety measures. Together, we discussed current protocols, explored options for identifying the right safety app for our community, and evaluated the security of all buildings on our campus.

Ms. Wetzel shared that she was impressed with the overall security of our campus. She will continue working with us to develop updated protocols to ensure that our school remains a safe and secure environment for all students, staff, and families.
