Carrigeen NS Healthy Lunch Policy

At Carrigeen NS, we promote healthy eating as part of our whole-school approach to wellbeing.

Since 2024, all pupils are provided with a free hot lunch daily through our current provider, Fresh Today. Children choose from a wide range of healthy, balanced hot meals. Parents/guardians are encouraged to support their child in selecting these lunches through the online menu system.

- Pupils may **opt out** of the hot lunches if they wish. In this case, they should bring a **healthy packed lunch from home** in line with the guidelines below.
At the **11am break**, all pupils are encouraged to have a small, healthy snack. This snack is provided from home.

Healthy Packed Lunches Guide

When sending in a packed lunch, please include a variety of the following options:

Sandwiches:

- Preferably on wholemeal bread, rolls, or a mixture of wholemeal and white.
- Suggested fillings include cheese, lean meat, chicken, turkey, tuna, salmon, egg.

Savouries:

- Slices of pizza, quiche, crackers and cheese, mixed salad in a container.
- Add variety with tomato, cucumber, lettuce, pickles, beetroot, gherkins.
- Carrot/celery sticks, or a whole tomato make excellent healthy nibbles.

Snacks:

- Fresh fruit of all kinds (e.g. apple, orange, mandarin, banana, pear, peach, plum, grapes).
- Dried fruit (e.g. sultanas, raisins, dates), yoghurt, popcorn, scones, brack, fruit cake, digestive biscuits.
