Farm Profiles

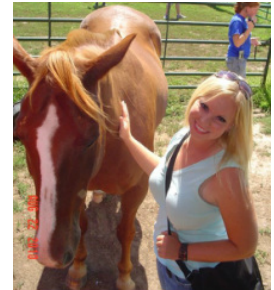
Crooked Creek Farms
