RE: LETTER OF COMMITMENT - Implementation of Gate Removal

Dear Ms. Matthews-Emery:

This letter is to confirm the New Brunswick Legal Aid Services Commission's commitment to those individuals who were at step 31(CPM) of the Lawyer 2 classification as of March 31, 2022. Upon the date of signing:

- 1. Those employees will be able to apply for the new Senior Lawyer classification immediately.
- 2. The employer undertakes that the applications of the employees currently at step 31 of the Lawyer 2 classification will be approved, effective the date of application. Once approved, those employees will be placed at step 3 of the Senior Lawyer classification.
- 3. Their 2022 anniversary date and performance review will be revised to the date of submission of Senior Lawyer Classification.
- 4. As a Senior Lawyer, as per schedule B, those employees will be eligible for a 2 step merit increase as well as 3 step discretionary increase for the review period of 2021-2022.
- 5. After the conclusion of this implementation procedure, the anniversary date of those employees would revert to the common anniversary date of April 1, 2023.
