# **WACKY BALL**

#### **OBJECTIVE:**

Get as many beach balls onto the opposing team's side before the time runs out.

#### **SUPPLIES NEEDED:**

- 1. 25+ Beach Balls (Large and small)
- 2. Pump to blow up the beach balls (if you have one) otherwise hot air works fine. It just may take longer depending on if you have anyone to help you or not.
- 3. Volleyball net
- 4. High energy background music recommended
- 5. score sheet and pencil

#### **TEAMS:**

2 teams

#### **SETUP:**

- 1. Setup a volley ball net across the length of the gym, or playing area.
- 2. Blow up the beach balls ahead of time. The more you have, the crazier it gets (having others help you will cut down on the time it takes).
- 3. If you are able, Having a few MEGA SIZE balls in the mix will make the game really awesome! However it does cost more to get them. If you can't the game is still really fun. These balls should be worth more points during game play.
- 4. At the start of the game, separate the students into two teams. One team per side.
- 5. Designate a leader to each team if you are able to (they will help count the balls each round and keep things fair).
- 6. Start off the game with each side having equal amount of balls on each side. However, this will not be necessary for any of the following rounds.

### **HOW TO PLAY:**

- 1. Have everyone sit in place at the start of each round.
- 2. At the start of the music, or when you say "GO", the game begins.
- 3. Students keep hitting the balls onto the opposing team's side in an attempt to get as many on their side as possible before the time is up.
- 4. When you are about to end the round, shout out a countdown from 10, and then stop the music and have all the students sit in place holding onto any balls they have on their side.
- 5. Once the round has stopped, if you see any students throwing balls onto the other team's side. (Judge accordingly to make it fair by putting any balls back onto the correct side as best as possible.)
- 6. Have each team leader count the balls on their side.
- 7. Each team will get points based on how many balls are on the opposing team's side. **Example:** If Team A has 20 balls on their side, then Team B would get 20,000 points. And if Team B had 10 balls on their side, then Team A would get 10,000 points. (See below for point system)

#### **POINTS:**

1000 points per regular ball 5000 points per MEGA BALL (really large balls) if you have any.

The team with the most points in the end wins!
