

Minutes of the General Education, Overlay, and Code Subcommittee
March 22, 2023

Kaatz called the meeting to order at 2:02.

1. Approval of the agenda **(M Palmieri/S White/P). (M Fleming/S White/P) to remove discussion of GE Honors courses.** (There were changes to the Honors Program made by ExCom and the discussion would happen after the Program resumes.)
2. Approval of the minutes **(M White/S Palmieri/P).**
3. Reports
 - a. Report of the Chair and Director of General Education. Kaatz highlighted a request from AD Calvo about the deadline on Curriculog of October 15. That is the date for it getting to the University (APS) level, but it needs to be submitted earlier. He said that CAPR is going to resume the GE Assessment Subcommittee
 - b. Report of APS. Watnik thanked members for their service this year. He said that the “beta” Catalog will be published on April 3, to coincide with the release of the fall schedule. Palmieri encouraged members to pay attention to the Career Counselor task force and respond to the survey.
4. Business / Discussion (all approvals below were unanimous unless specified otherwise)
 - a. [A1/A2/A3/B4 courses](#) for recertification, Fall 2023. Kaatz noted that there are 16 courses up for recertification. Watnik explained that the “E” courses (e.g., MATH 110E) are equivalent to their non-“E” counterparts, but have an extra unit for discussion. Those courses should not need separate GE recertification. There was additional discussion about the possibility of additional proposals, particularly for A3.
5. Old Business/Discussion
 - a. Revised [Checklist](#) we can give chairs/college curriculum committees for working on their recertification proposals **(M Kim/S Palmieri/P) to approve the checklist.**
6. Adjournment. Prior to adjournment, there was discussion of Kim getting a sabbatical next year and other members’ consideration of returning. Members thanked and acknowledged Kaatz’ leadership of GEOC this year. **(M Palmieri/S Liberti/ P). The meeting adjourned at 2:28 PM.**
