Child Find: Special Education and/or Section 504 Notice

The Coopersville Area Public Schools District offers evaluations, programs, and services to individuals who are identified as having, or who are suspected of having, a disability as defined in either the Individuals with Disabilities Act (IDEA) or Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973. These services are available to eligible persons ages 0-26 who reside within, or attend a K-12 school program within the school district's attendance boundaries. Regulation/Rule:

§300.111 Child Find (a) General. (1) The state must have in effect policies and procedures to ensure that (i) All children with disabilities residing in the state including children with disabilities who are homeless children or are wards of the state, and children with disabilities attending private schools, regardless of the severity of their disability, and who need special education and related services, are identified, located, and evaluated.
