

WGC Junior passport

Dedicated to junior golf

The WGC passport is an education program aimed to provide all junior golfers with the below competencies of skill within golf. It is a requirement for all junior golfers to have completed the passport before they can play on the golf courses.

- **Skill competency**
- **Rules competency**
- **Etiquette competency**

Skill Competency

Junior golfers will have to demonstrate competent playing skills in the below key pillars of golf:

- Long-Game
- Approach
- Short-game
- Putting

Long-game

- Demonstrate a 70 yards tee shot within a 50 yards width 80% of the time using 5 balls

Approach

- Demonstrate a shot from the ground that can travel past 50 yards 100% of the time using 5 balls within a 50 yards width

Short-game

- From 15 yards of the centre of the green, demonstrate a shot can finish on the green 80% of the time using 5 balls

Putting

- Complete a 20ft putt in 3 putts or fewer using 4 balls with 100% success
- Complete a 40ft putt in 3 putts or fewer using 4 balls with 50% success

Rules Competency

Using a multiple question test, juniors will have to demonstrate some core rules & etiquette knowledge. [Click here](#) for a link to the required answers and click [HERE](#) for the test:

Etiquette Competency

- Behaviour around the golf club
- Clubhouse dress code
- How to behave when on the course
- Integrity within golf
- Stray tee shots from the Vardon 1st
