Students will discover why it is important in today's world to study our country's past. The course emphasizes significant people, events, themes, governmental structures, economic developments, and social themes.

ABOUT AP LANGUAGE AND COMPOSITION

Students in this course will develop flexibility and skill in a variety of writing modes, which can be applied in all subject areas in college, as well as in personal and professional situations. Writing will focus on narration, exposition, and argumentation modes. Students will read a variety of non-fiction as models for their writing. Emphasis will be placed on acquiring the skills necessary to pass the AP English Language and Composition exam, through which they may receive English credit at most colleges and universities.



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
