

LAKE CITY HALL OF FAME NOMINATION PACKET

Categories of Recognition

1. Athletics

To recognize and honor those who have established outstanding records of achievement in athletics. Nominees for Athletics must have graduated from Lincoln High School at least 10 years prior to nomination. A point system based on an individual's accomplishments during their participation in athletics **may be** used to determine nominees that will be selected for the Hall of Fame.

Selection Committee members will also take into account a candidate's philanthropy, character, and community athletic involvement and can award up to 10 additional points.

2. Outstanding Life Work

To recognize and honor those who have distinguished themselves while pursuing excellence in their chosen field of endeavor at a local, national or international level. Nominees for Outstanding Life Work Accomplishment must have graduated from Lincoln high School at least 10 years prior to nomination.

3. Fine Arts

To recognize and honor those who have shown a long term commitment to Fine Arts, in their community, college, or professional career. Nominees will demonstrate a promotion of excellence in study, preparation, and/or involvement of the fine arts. This includes choral, band, theatrical, speech, visual arts, and other relevant fine art activities. Nominees for Fine Arts must have graduated from Lincoln High School at least 10 years prior to nomination and/or played a significant role in the Fine Arts programs at Lake City Public Schools.

Qualifications must include:

- A. Participation for at least three high school years in any of the following categories.
 - . Band
 - . Chorus
 - . Theatre Arts
 - . Speech
 - . Visual Arts
 - . Relevant Fine Arts Activities
- B. Refining or embellishing his or her talents in post high school education to the Highest level of attainment within their ability, whether college, community, or professional performance.
- C. Representation of dedication, inspiration, and artistic integrity in their chosen Fine Arts discipline.

4. Outstanding Contribution

To recognize and honor those members of our community who have given unselfishly to promote our schools and serve as a positive influence to our students. Nominees will have contributed significantly through a long standing commitment to Lake City Schools by example, service, and/or sustained contribution. Nominees for Outstanding Contribution do not have to be a graduate of Lake City Public Schools.

5. Team

To recognize and honor those members of a team that have accomplished an outstanding achievement and/or made a significant impact on Lincoln High School and/or the community. A team shall be eligible for induction as one inductee. The induction of a team shall not prohibit the separate induction of one or more of its members. Nomination information for teams should include team year, all coaches' names, team members' names and accomplishments of said team. The team must have competed at least (10) years prior to nomination.

Nomination Procedures

All nominations are due by the first Friday in May of the induction year. Induction ceremonies will take place on odd numbered years. (Homecoming or Home Football game 2021, 2023, etc.)

Nominations must be submitted to the Activities Director no later than 1:00 p.m. on the due date.

Nominations will stay active for ten (10) years and can be updated any time during the ten (10) years from the date of application.

Hall of Fame selections each ceremony will be limited to no more than two (2) from each of the five (5) categories.
