

Story Structure:

1. Initial Action: The event that starts the conflict rolling.
2. Rising Action: The series of events that lead to the climax.
3. Climax: The part of the story with the most action/suspense.
4. Falling Action: The wrapping up of loose ends after the climax.
5. Resolution/: The conclusion of the story; how the conflict was settled.

Within the above structure, stories contain a:

Setting-where the story happens

Protagonist-the main character in the story

Antagonist-the main character that opposes the Protagonist

Conflict (5 main types)-Character vs self, Character vs society, Character vs Another

Character, Character vs Nature, Character vs Supernatural
