ELA 7 Prep

Grades: incoming 7th grade

Course Length: 2 weeks

Course Description: This course is designed for incoming 7th graders who have been identified as below grade level in 6th grade reading and/or writing OR students who have previously failed 6th grade English. It will reinforce essential 6th grade English reading and writing concepts and skills, provide an opportunity for students to build their skills, and prepare them to be successful in English 7.

ELA 8 Prep

Grades: incoming 8th grade

Course Length: 2 weeks

Course Description: This course is designed for incoming 8th graders who have been identified as below grade level in 7th grade reading and/or writing OR students who have previously failed 7th grade English. It will reinforce essential 7th grade English reading and writing concepts and skills, provide an opportunity for students to build their skills, and prepare them to be successful in English 8.

ELA 9 (High School English) Prep

Grades: incoming 9th grade

Course Length: 2 weeks

Course Description: This course is designed for incoming 9th graders who have been identified as below grade level in 8th grade reading and/or writing OR students who have previously failed 8th grade English. It will reinforce essential 8th grade English reading and writing concepts and skills, provide an opportunity for students to build their skills, and prepare them to be successful in English 9.

Junior High Course Descriptions Math



Math 7 Prep

Grades: incoming 7th grade

Course Length: 2 weeks

Course Description: This course is designed for incoming 7th graders who have been identified as below grade level in 6th grade math and/or who have previously failed 6th grade math. It will reinforce essential 6th grade math concepts and skills as well as introduce students to beginning 7th grade math concepts with the goal of preparing students to be successful in Math 7.

Math Bridge to Honors Pre-Algebra

Grades: incoming 7th grade

Course Length: 4 weeks

Course Description: This course is designed for incoming 7th graders who took on-level 6th grade math and plan to take Honors Pre-Algebra. It will reinforce essential 6th grade math concepts and skills and provide instruction of priority standards from Math 7 to ensure that students are prepared to move into the accelerated and rigorous Honors Pre-Algebra curriculum. Students may also take this course if they took an accelerated 6th grade math course and want to review key concepts and skills before taking Honors Pre-Algebra.

Pre-Algebra Prep

Grades: incoming 8th grade

Course Length: 2 weeks

Course Description: This course is designed for incoming 8th graders who have been identified as below grade level in Math 7 and/or who have previously failed Math 7. It will reinforce essential Math 7 concepts and skills as well as introduce students to beginning Pre-Algebra concepts with the goal of preparing students to be successful in Pre-Algebra.

Math Bridge to Honors Algebra 1

Grades: incoming 8th grade

Course Length: 4 weeks

Course Description: This course is designed for incoming 8th graders who took on-level 7th grade math and plan to take Honors Algebra 1. It will reinforce essential Math 7 concepts and skills and provide instruction of priority standards from Pre-Algebra to ensure that students are prepared to move into the accelerated and rigorous Honors Algebra 1 curriculum. Students may also take this course if they took Honors Pre-Algebra and want to review key concepts and skills before taking Honors Algebra 1.

Algebra 1 Prep

Grades: incoming 9th grade

Course Length: 2 weeks

Course Description: This course is designed for incoming 9th graders who have been identified as below grade level in Pre-Algebra and/or who have previously failed Pre-Algebra. It will emphasize essential Pre-Algebra concepts and skills as well as introduce students to beginning Algebra 1 concepts with the goal of preparing students to be successful in Algebra 1.
