Instructional Designer Reviews the Curriculum Design Framework with faculty member. Learning goals and objectives are reviewed.

# 2. Develop Plan, Resources

- (2 4 meetings 15 30 minutes)
  - a. Meeting #1.
    - Information about the student group: type degree, comfort with technology,
    - Information about the faculty member's experiences with using technology
    - Types of learning activities currently being used
    - Instructional resources currently using.
  - b. Meeting #2.

- Instructional Designer shares draft learning plan and new ideas
- Discuss explicitly which elements can be used almost as-is, which are unclear, and which seem impossible to apply soon for the instructor
- Discuss explicitly HOW, WHEN, to begin using first recommendations
- INCLUDE AT LEAST 2 ELEMENTS:
- a. Something to assign to students for them to do/use outside of course meeting sessions
- b. Something to do with students during a course meeting session that would depend on or respond to the "a." assignment
- c. Meeting #3.
