*The tuition and fees indicated above are calculated based on the cohort of students who entered UCSC during the 2021-2022 Academic Year or before. If you entered UCSC after the 2021-2022 Academic Year, please confirm what cohort tuition and fees you will be billed on this webpage. Tuition and fees are charged per quarter enrolled in a UCSC Exchange. Tuition and fees indicated here are estimates based on currently approved amounts. These figures may not be final. Students who pay Non-Resident Tuition (NRT) at UCSC must also pay Non-Resident Tuition per quarter enrolled in a UCSC Exchange. Actual tuition, fees, and charges are subject to change by the Regents of the University of California and could be affected by State funding reductions. Accordingly, final approved levels, and thus a student's final balance due to UCSC, may differ from the amounts shown.

Includes the \$300 Non-Refundable Application Fee, and International Health Insurance. The International Health Insurance fee **is estimated and subject to change. The Non-Refundable Application Fee will be billed to your UCSC account about 1 month after you apply in the Global Learning Portal. You agree to pay this fee by the deadline as set by Student Business Services. The International Health Insurance is billed in one lump sum and due at the same time as your quarterly tuition & fees. In some cases, you may be charged an additional International Health fee again at a later date if insurance fees amounts/terms are adjusted in accordance with your actual program dates and your insurance fee increases. See the Student Business Services billing schedule.

***The UCSC Student Health Center requires all students to be covered by a domestic healthcare plan while abroad, and thus, all students are automatically enrolled in UC SHIP for each term they are enrolled in a UCSC Exchange Program. This fee will be assessed at a reduced rate on a student's UCSC account and must be paid according to the UCSC Student Business Services billing schedule. If a student is already enrolled in another domestic health insurance program (such as through a family plan) and that insurance meets the UC SHIP requirements, the student can waive out of the UC SHIP insurance. Financial aid will not cover the health insurance cost for students who choose to waive out of UC SHIP. The cost is estimated and subject to change.
