Admissions Requirements

- Bachelor's degree in psychology, counseling, leadership, ministry, or a related field
- Minimum GPA of 3.0
- Two letters of recommendation from professional or faith-based mentors
- Statement of purpose outlining career goals in coaching and faith-based mentorship
- Interview with faculty admissions committee

Practicum Requirement

Students must complete a 300-hour supervised practicum in a coaching organization, leadership training program, or faith-based mentoring

initiative. This hands-on experience provides direct interaction with clients seeking guidance in personal and professional growth.

Master's Thesis

A master's thesis is required, focusing on coaching methodologies, faith-based mentoring strategies, or personal development techniques.

The thesis should be between 60-100 pages, follow APA formatting, and present innovative coaching models that integrate spiritual and psychological principles.
