



The Global Student & AI Rights Declaration - DRAFT

A Platform for Equitable Educational Innovation

The People's Call to Educational Institutions and Technology Providers

I stand for equitable, ethical, and human-centered education in the age of artificial intelligence. I hereby join the call for a Global Declaration to Ensure Student Rights and Ethical AI Integration in Education.

Affirm the fundamental right of every student to quality education that balances technological innovation with age-appropriate ethical standards, humane values, cultural preservation, and individual dignity.

Recognize that AI and digital technologies, while powerful tools for educational advancement, must be implemented to safeguard student privacy, to let technology support but never supplant the human connection on which teaching and learning are based, and the focus should be on learning outcomes, not digital inputs.¹

Acknowledge the UN Sustainable Development Goal 4.7 and existing frameworks promoting global citizenship education, technology in education, and sustainable development education;

Express concern that despite technological advancement, digital divides and educational inequities continue to exclude millions from quality education; and the risks associated with excessive screen time, coupled with the growing influence of commercial and private tech interests in education, pose significant threats to students' mental and social well-being.

Resolve that the adoption of this declaration will strengthen student rights and ensure ethical AI implementation in education through the following articles:

Article 1: All participating parties shall commit to comprehensive educational reform:

1. Reform educational policies to ensure equitable access to AI and digital learning tools while protecting student privacy and their social and mental well-being.
2. Implement teacher training and support systems that balance technological integration with human-centered pedagogy.
3. Provide the infrastructure and resources necessary for ethical AI implementation in education. Legally guarantee the privacy of educational data and prevent the exploitation of students' vulnerabilities for commercial or profit-making purposes.
4. Enact evidence-based guidelines for AI use in education that preserve human connection and cultural diversity.

Article 2: Establish monitoring and accountability mechanisms to ensure ethical AI implementation and student data protection across all participating nations to ensure that technology and AI serve education, not the other way round nor for profit making.

Article 3: Create a global implementation fund to finance educational infrastructure, teacher training, and ethical AI development in underserved regions, focusing on human-centered technology and AI use.

Article 4: Guarantee student and community rights to ethical and educational agency centering on students' social and mental well-being, data privacy, and cultural preservation in AI-supported learning environments.

I hereby urge nations to adopt the Declaration, mandating that governments, educational institutions, and technology providers alike undertake the work required to ensure ethical, equitable, and human-centered AI integration in education worldwide.
