

Corcoran Margaritaville House Information for Guests

Welcome to our Orlando cottage at Margaritaville! We have some information we hope you will find helpful.

Address:

2982 Salted Rim Road
Cottage name "Our Dream Come True"

Arrival/Check-in:

Go to the Margaritaville Hotel main building, **8000 Fins Up Cir, Kissimmee, FL 34747**

Check-in time is 4:00 pm; check out is 11:00 am

The check-in desk is to the right as you enter the lobby; go to the "Rentyl Cottages Check-in" which is the first desk on the right. Let them know you are checking into 2982 Salted Rim Road as a guest of owner. They will give you room key cards and directions to the cottage. There is a shuttle that will take you to the cottage.

If you are driving, as you leave the lobby, you will take the first right (Fins Up Blvd) and drive around the side of the hotel, past the spa and gym. You will come to a security station – simply push the green button and the gate will open. Keep driving a couple blocks on Fins Up Blvd (you will see a security station on the left); just past the security station take a right on Dreamsicle Dr. and then an immediate left on Salted Rim Rd. 2982 Salted rim is the 9th house on the right. Your key card should get you in the front door. Often at check in they will give you a code for a back door lock box – if they do just FYI it is a mistake; our model does not have a back security code unit.



House Amenities

Bedrooms:

Total of 5 bedrooms each with their own bathroom. First floor, 2 bedrooms with queen beds, 2nd floor 2 bedrooms with queen beds and a primary bedroom with a king bed. The primary bedroom is larger and has a balcony deck.

There is also a small sofa bed (full-size) in the family room on 1st floor.

Kitchen:

Fully stocked kitchen on 1st floor with:
Basic cooking utensils and dinnerware
Refrigerator/freezer,
Stovetop oven
Microwave
Coffeemaker (they provide coffee for about 3 pots of coffee)
Margarita maker machine

Patio:

There is a patio in back with a table that seats 6. On the patio there is a door leading into a powder bath.

Laundry:

On 2nd floor there is a laundry room in the hallway by the 2 smaller upper bedrooms. Laundry detergent for 1 – 2 loads is provided.

Towels/Linens/Housekeeping:

Towels and bed linens are provided. There is not a daily housekeeping service. (Housekeeping can be requested at an extra charge.)

Trash:

There is a large trash can with a white trash bag in the kitchen. There are more trash bags under the kitchen sink. Outside in front of the cottage there is a wicker rectangular storage container for trash. All trash that goes in there must be in the kitchen trash bags. Boxes for recycle can be flattened and put in the outdoor trash container.

Security:

Be sure to lock the back patio door when you leave, and make sure you fully pull the front door shut. If you misplace your key card go to the front desk and show identification and they will help you, or call the hotel security 347-818-8273 (you will see them driving around in security cars).

Resort On-Site Amenities

- Euphoria full-service restaurant/lounge in hotel lobby
- Salted Rim restaurant/bar at the pool
- Provisions – smaller service food and supplies at the hotel lobby
- St. Somewhere Spa
- Gym
- Lagoon pools and Fins Up Beach Club (we will have registered you to go to this – it will be free, be sure to have your room key card and id. They provide towels)
- Island H2O Water Park (this is a fun water park on property; there is a charge per person to go in)
- The Promenade at Sunset Walk, our nearby shopping, dining, and entertainment district.

Fins Up Beach Club:

We will have registered you in advance. You will need your cottage key card, unit address (2982 Salted Rim Road) and id to get in. There is a small check in shack – go there to get checked in. They provide towels. There is a bar/grill, 2 pools, various activities each day. There are cabanas for rent, we highly recommend them. They have a 24-hour cancellation policy. You can reserve them at the pool check in shack. At the shack they will also blow up any pool toys you bring that need air.

Shuttle on Site:

There is a shuttle that will take you around the resort.

Shuttle to Parks:

There is a daily shuttle to Disneyworld, SeaWorld and Universal Studios. You need to register at least 1 hour prior to departure time, see the desk in the hotel lobby for

departure times. There are usually a few morning departure times for Disney and 1 early departure time for both SeaWorld and Universal. If we take a shuttle we will often take the shuttle to the park and then just Uber home so we are not locked into a specific return time. Taking the shuttle saves you the cost of the Disney parking.

Rental Cars:

You can rent at the airport or there is a Sixt rental in the Margaritaville hotel lobby. If you go that route you can take and Uber to/from the hotel from the airport and pick up your car at the hotel. We have found that there can be very long lines/waits at the airport rental car check-in (especially Thrifty – sometimes a 2 hour wait). If you get your car at the hotel you also save a number of additional taxes/fees imposed at the airport rental facilities. However, the one downside of renting through Sixt is that they have contacted us post-trip a number of times to say that there was damage to our vehicle. We have disputed that by taking pictures when we pick up the vehicle, and then walking through a visual check (with pictures) with a Sixt staff person when we return the vehicle and we have avoided any problems. We still find this the easiest option, but just be aware if you are renting from them.

Pets:

No pets are allowed. You may see some people with pets – they are owners. Only owners may have pets on property.

Groceries:

There is a Super Target with a grocery store and liquor store very close by. There is also a Publix supermarket a few blocks further away.

Gym: There is a nice facility on site next to the St. Somewhere Spa, near the pool. It has free weights, kettlebells, weight machines, a couple treadmills and a couple ellipticals and a stationary bike. Your cottage key card is used to open the locked door to the facility.

Check-Out:

Check-out is 11:00 am the day of your departure. Please remove any extra food from the refrigerator/freezer and put in the trash. Bed linens can be left on the beds and bathroom towels left in bathroom. Cleaning staff will refresh all bed/bath linens. Leave key cards on the kitchen counter. Please put dishes in dishwasher and start it prior to leaving.

Restaurants

Here are some restaurants we enjoy (all are in general vicinity of Margaritaville unless indicated otherwise):

Euphoria – in hotel lobby: excellent breakfast. We have not been there for lunch/dinner but menu looks good

Salty Rim Bar/Grill: at the pool – decent but expensive

Flippers Pizza: Decent dine in or takeout pizza by Super Target

Buffalo Wild Wings

Miller's Ale House: sports bar with burgers, sandwiches

Sickies – burgers, sandwiches

Sakura Asian Fusion - ok for sushi/Asian food

Divine Indian – ok for Indian food

The Wharf at Sunset Walk – has live music, good food/drinks

Columbia – further from Margaritaville in Celebration area – great Cuban food

Cuba Libre – further from Margaritaville in downtown Orlando – great Cuban Food

Winter Park, FL – lots of restaurants – cute place to visit. We have stopped in at “The Porch” for lunch – it is good/casual spot

At the Disney Parks:

Magic Kingdom – for a special dinner get reservations at the California Grill at the Contemporary Hotel. Amazing food and views, and they give you a ticket to return to their special viewing deck for evening fireworks – amazing view.

Not food – but also highly recommend the “Keys to the Kingdom” tour – a 4-5 hour behind the scenes tour of Magic Kingdom. Need reservations.

Animal Kingdom: Tiffins – either the bar side or the restaurant.

Epcot: Chefs du France, Spice Road
