-Remaining training balance and any incidental expenses must be paid at the time the horse is picked up.

-One riding lesson included.

The horse shall be in a healthy and sound condition, free from infectious contagious or transmissible disease. Christine Knight reserves the right to refuse the horse if not in satisfactory condition.

Christine Knight will not be held liable for the level at which the horse will progress through the training period. At the end of the Training, there will be a demonstration made by Christine Knight, on how the horse has progressed.

Should the horse become sick or injured, Christine Knight will attempt to contact the owner immediately, if the owner is unavailable and Christine Knight feels measures need to be taken for the horse's well being or safety, Christine Knight is authorized to request the services of a Vet to give any attention that appears or is deemed necessary. If the horse is injured or lame, then the agreed daily boarding fee will apply, while the horse cannot be in Training.

Christine Knight is not responsible for any damage, injury, or theft to the owner's horse, tack, or equipment. Christine Knight encourages owners to carry insurance on their horse. The owner has inspected the facilities and finds the facilities provide adequate and reasonable levels of safety and is in acceptable order. It is understood that each horse is unique and Christine Knight cannot guarantee all aspects of the horse's safety at all times. The owner understands that the training of a horse can place the horse above normal stress both physically and mentally and Christine Knight

is not responsible for the results of reasonable levels of stress, which could potentially cause injury, illness, and/or loss of the horse by death.

Warning: Under Iowa law, a domesticated animal professional is not liable for damages suffered by, an injury to, or the death of a participant resulting from the inherent risks of domesticated animal activities, pursuant to Iowa Code chapter 673. You are assuming inherent risks of participating in this domesticated animal activity.

Disclaimer: A number of inherent risks are associated with a domesticated animal activity. A domesticated animal may behave in a manner that results in damages to property or an injury or death to a person. Risks associated with the activity may include injuries caused by bucking, biting, stumbling, rearing, trampling, scratching, pecking, falling, or butting.

The domesticated animal may react unpredictably to conditions, including, but not limited to, a sudden movement, loud noise, an unfamiliar environment, or the introduction of unfamiliar persons, animals, or objects.

The domesticated animal may also react in a dangerous manner when a condition or treatment is considered hazardous to the welfare of the animal; a collision occurs with an object or animal; or a participant fails to exercise reasonable care, take adequate precautions, or use adequate control when engaging in a domesticated animal activity, including failing to maintain reasonable control of the animal or failing to act in a manner consistent with the person's abilities.
