RAINY DAY Dismissal Procedure for Walkers and Bikers

All walkers and bikers should be car riders when weather conditions warrant a rainy day/severe weather alternate dismissal.

- Parents will be asked to join the car rider line and follow the route shown by the map.
 You will not be able to turn left into the entrance by the marquee. You will need to join at the end of the car rider line.
- Display your walker/biker/car rider sign in your windshield. *If you do not have a sign, you will need to present your ID and wait for your ID to be verified. Please expect a wait, as we adhere to our safety protocols.*
- You will not be allowed to pick up your student in the staff parking lot or at the front desk. Also, please do not block the bus ramp entrance on the west side of the building on Firehouse Road. The buses cannot be blocked from entering and exiting the bus ramp, as it affects not only our dismissal, but the Irons JH route as well.

In the *rare* circumstance that your child cannot be picked up by car, line up outside the walker door by the bike racks..

• Display your walker sign or car rider sign. If you do not have a sign, you will need to present your ID and wait for your ID to be verified. Please expect a wait, as we adhere to our safety protocols.

Students who are normally released to the RV Park will dismiss as normal unless the school has been notified of alternative arrangements.

Thank you for understanding that we have limited staff available to assist you. Our priority is student safety. Please be prepared for dismissal to take longer on these rainy day/severe weather alternate dismissal days.
