## **III. Faculty Senate Chair Annual Report (Patrick O'Brien reporting for Kyle Anderson)**

- APPC
  - A new AI resolution will be presented at the December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023 Faculty Senate meeting.
- TLRC
  - November 15<sup>th</sup> ChatGPT event was re-scheduled due to Provost candidate interviews. The new date is December 6<sup>th</sup> during Common Hour.
- SSEI Institutional Transformation Assessment was sent out on November 8<sup>th</sup> from Kyle. There are many high-level questions but you can always answer "unsure" if you don't know.
- The CUTE survey was sent out on 10/24. It may have come to your spam box or "other" inbox, so need to check both places.
  - There are many questions but you can chose not to any questions.
  - Shanthy Konkoth contacted Indiana University (the institution overseeing the administration of the survey) regarding the language concerning anonymity of the survey.
    - Since there are write-in questions, Indiana University cannot control if a respondent self-identifies in their responses inadvertently. In the situation of a court-order, the data might need to be turned over but only after a lengthy court battle.
  - Presidential Committees: Working to appoint people to the new, updated Presidential Committee structure (Campus Life, Operational Excellence, Planning & Budget, and IT Governance and Advisory). If you previously served on a Presidential Committee and want to continue on to serve, please contact Kyle.
  - Provost Search – finalist candidates on-campus interviews taking place this week (November 14<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup>). There will be an open fora for the candidates to meet with the campus community during Common Hour. Candidates' CVs will be distributed two days before the interviews.
  - Four faculty vacancies on the Student Conduct Committee – 2 SAS and 2 At-Large.
  - Faculty needed to serve on the Strategic Planning Student Success and Growth Strategic Subcommittee, and the Operational Excellence and Campus Life Presidential Committees.

## **IV. President's Report (Timothy Sams)**

- DEI – Faculty, Professionals, and Staff of Color
  - Will continue to support both PRODiG and Faculty of Color
    - Renewed commitment to PRODiG. PRODiG has been revamped to PRODiG+
      - PRODiG+ to support 400+ tenured-track, committed to DEI over next 10 years
      - 2-year fellowship leading to tenured-track position
        - Funding for salary and professional development
- SUNY Budget Increases -- \$4 million

- OTPS -- \$2.6 million permanent funding
- Incremental (ongoing) -- \$738K
  - Mental health
  - Student support with different abilities
  - Placement (Career Services)
  - Emergency funding
- Transformational -- \$1.1 million
  - Workforce Development
  - Student Support
  - Bridge Programs
- Create faculty housing (8-10 units)
  - Timeline of 20 months
- Financial Sustainability
  - Advocacy for budget increases from NYS to erase budgeting gaps on SUNY campuses.
  - Increase SUNY enrollment by 500K students by 2030 (increase enrollment approximately by 5100 students at OW; current enrollment is 4450 students).
    - Early applications; Expand EOP SUNY; and Transfer Match (identify a place for every SUNY applicant).
  - Campus-based Financial Plan (template)
    - SUNY request to all campuses to address the following:
      - Future growth and positioning
      - Retention and enrollment strategy
      - Operationalize collaboration (utilize SUNY as a centralize backroom operations; partner with other SUNY campuses to share and operationalize responsibilities)
      - Academic portfolio optimization and things to improve
      - Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion
      - Proper fiscal management
    - Align financial plan with OW's strategic plan
  - Criteria for Promotion and Tenure
    - Associate Professor – Teaching excellence; service and professional activities.
    - Full Professor – Continued and significant achievement beyond the Associate Professor level in teaching excellence with service and professional activities.
    - Alignment of package material with recommendation letters; congruency between the two.
      - Update coming through revamped faculty handbook.
  - Upcoming Community Talk and State of the University
    - 12/5 – 1:30PM or 2:15PM, L313 “Together Towards Tomorrow”
    - 1/23 – 9AM, NAB1100 and Zoom “State of the University” progress report.
  - Shared Governance and Consultation Policy
    - Formulating the vetting process of drafting new policies

#### **V. University Faculty Senate (UFS) (Runi Mukherji)**

- SUNY Board of Trustees passed a resolution on Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, and Justice

- Issues of Enrollment Drop – SUNY-wide aggressive approach to enrollment and retention:
  - Creating microcredentials; building pipelines; and building workforce.
  - New initiative on Civil Education and Civic Engagement.
  - Studying the reasons for students dropping out.
- Academic Program Optimization
  - Conserve allocations and optimize operations.
- Two UFS resolutions were presented for OW Faculty Senate endorsement:
  - Continued support for the micro credential program.
  - Algorithm for budget allocation to be rethought.

#### **VI. UUP (Peter Ikeler)**

- New pay rates will kick in with 11/22/2023 paycheck with retro pay.
- In December, a \$400.00 DSI increase.
- One time signing bonus in July 2024.
- Adjunct course to increase \$7000.00/course by 2026.
- In solidarity with SUNY Potsdam
- 12/12/2023 – Holiday celebration

#### **VII. Panther Care Support (Randall Eduord)**

- Introducing the Care Team at the Panther Care Center
  - Using the Consultation, Advocacy, Referral, Education (CARE) Model to address the health, welfare, maintenance of OW students through a food pantry.
  - Care Team members: Jenny Garoly, LCSW and Jean Telfort, LCSW.
  - Address food insecurity, housing insecurity, and issues of transportation.

#### **VIII. FUAC Annual Report (Alireza Ebrahimi)**

- Standing committee that nominates faculty and staff for SUNY Chancellor's Awards in Excellence:
  - Excellence in Teaching,
  - Excellence in Faculty Service,
  - Excellence in Professional Service;
  - Distinguished Professor;
  - Excellence in Scholarship and Creative Activities;
  - Adjunct Excellence in Teaching;
  - Excellence in Librarianship;
  - Excellence in Professional Service; and
  - Shared Governance
- Had 7 meetings in 2022-2023 academic year to review portfolio nominations for:
  - Excellence in Teaching (1);
  - Excellence in Faculty Service (2); and
  - Excellence in Professional Service (1).
  - There was one nomination for Distinguished Professor but the portfolio was withdrawn by the nominee and nominator.
- Of the 4 nominations, 1 Excellence in Teaching, 1 Excellence in Faculty Service, and 1 Excellence in Professional Service were supported and sent forth to the administration for deliberation and submission to SUNY-level administrators. All three nominations were awarded.
- Offered Q and A session on portfolio preparation for faculty.

- Worked to increase more equity, inclusion, and diversity of its membership with respect to its roles in evaluating a wide range of nominees to provide a more broad and fair review of all nominee's portfolios consistent with its updated by-laws. These by-laws were submitted to Faculty Senate for review and approved by Fall 2023.
- The annual report was accepted by acclamation.
