

Chamber and Fox Class Mission Homework – Spring A 2026

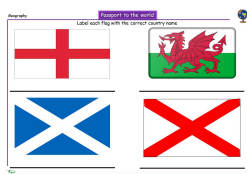

Geography

In geography this term, we will be learning about the United Kingdom. With an adult's help, create a fact file about popular tourist attractions/cities within one of the countries.

Religious Education

In RE this term we will be learning about the religion of Islam. We will be learning about the importance of the Five Pillars of Islam for Muslims. The most important pillar is Shahada - declaration of faith to God. Can you research the four other pillars of Islam and explain what they are? Or you might like to produce a page in your journal which shares what your most important things are.

Science-

Can you make a boat using different materials from around your home?

Your toy needs to cross water, but the boat must float. Use 3 different materials to build your own mini boat.

Test your boat by placing it in water. Does it float with the toy inside? Which material works best?

In your learning journal, draw or write: what materials you used, what worked well, and what you would do differently next time. You could take a photo of your finished boat with your toy inside.

Science

Can you find the most absorbent material in your home? You have spilled some water and need to clean it up quickly. Use 3 different materials to soak up the same amount of water. Test each material by dipping it into the water. Which material absorbs the most water?

In your learning journal, draw or write: what materials you used, what happened, and which material worked best.

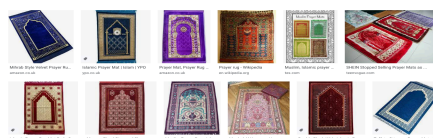
