Scissors (paper & fabric, small curved sharp)

Rotary Cutter, Ruler

Pen or Pencil

Frixion Marking Pencil

Black cotton or silk covered thread (Blanket Stitch)

Chalk marker

Applique Pressing Sheet

FABRICS:

Background/Backing: 1/3 yard

Batting: 1/3 yard

Applique fabrics: Assorted fabric for applique

BEFORE CLASS:

Trace applique patterns on the paper side of the fusible web, cut 1/8" from drawn line press onto the back of fabric; cut out applique shapes on the drawn line. If you have not used fusible web you may trace in class. Do not cut the circle out, you may cut a 12" square from your background fabrics.

INFORMATION:

These patterns are made for wool applique, I made mine from flannels, you may also use cotton, you will have to add to the fusible web when you are tracing the pattern where the appliques go under another applique, if using fabrics or flannel.

*WOF-Width of Fabric
