Romans 1:16-17 KJV

[16] **For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek. [17] For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, The just shall live by faith.**

Gethsemane

Matthew 26:39,42 KJV

[39] And he went a little further, and fell on his face, and prayed, saying, **O my Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me: nevertheless not as I will, but as thou wilt.** [42] He went away again the second time, and prayed, saying, **O my Father, if this cup may not pass away from me, except I drink it, thy will be done.**

Acts 8:32 KJV

[32] The place of the scripture which he read was this, **He was led as a sheep to the slaughter;** and like a lamb dumb before his shearer, so opened he not his mouth:

Isaiah 53:7 KJV

[7] He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: **he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb,** so he openeth not his mouth.

Abraham/Father And Son

Genesis 22:1-2 KJV

[1] And it came to pass after these things, **that God did tempt Abraham,** and said unto him, Abraham: and he

said, Behold, here I am. [2] **And he said, Take now thy son, thine only son Isaac, whom thou lovest, and get thee into the land of Moriah; and offer him there for a burnt offering upon one of the mountains which I will tell thee of.**

“Even now he did not murmur against God, but strengthened his soul by **dwelling upon the evidences of the Lord's goodness and faithfulness**. This son had been unexpectedly given; and had not He who bestowed the precious gift a right to recall His own? **Then faith repeated the promise**, “In Isaac shall thy seed be called” — a seed numberless as the grains of sand upon the shore. **Isaac was the child of a miracle, and could not the power that gave him life restore it? Looking beyond that which was seen, Abraham grasped the divine word, “accounting that God was able to raise him up, even from the dead.”** Hebrews 11:19.. PP 151.4

“At the appointed place they built the altar and laid the wood upon it. **Then, with trembling voice, Abraham unfolded to his son the divine message. It was with terror and amazement that Isaac learned his fate, but he offered no resistance. He could have escaped his doom, had he chosen to do so;** the grief-stricken old man, exhausted with the struggle of those three terrible days, could not have opposed the will of the vigorous youth. **But Isaac had been trained from childhood to**

ready, trusting obedience, and as the purpose of God was opened before him, he yielded a willing submission.” PP 152.2

The Walk

Luke 24:13-18 KJV

[13] And, behold, two of them went that same day to a village called Emmaus, which was from Jerusalem about threescore furlongs. [14] **And they talked together of all these things which had happened.** [15] And it came to pass, that, **while they communed together and reasoned, Jesus himself drew near, and went with them.** [16] **But their eyes were holden that they should not know him.** [17] And he said unto them, What manner of communications are these that ye have one to another, as ye walk, and are sad?

Ezekiel 13:22 KJV

[22] **Because with lies ye have made the heart of the righteous sad, whom I have not made sad**; and strengthened the hands of the wicked, that he should not return from his wicked way, by promising him life:

[18] **And the one of them, whose name was Cleopas, answering** said unto him, Art thou only a stranger in Jerusalem, and hast not known the things which are come to pass there in these days?

G2810-Cleopas-(**compounded from [G2811](#) and [G3962](#)**); *Cleopas*, a Christian:

G2811-From a shorter form of [G2564](#); *renown* (**as if *being called***): - glory

G2564-Akin to the base of [G2753](#); to “**call**” (properly aloud, but used in a variety of applications, directly or otherwise): - **bid, call (forth)**, (whose, whose sur-) name (was [called]).

John 11:43-44 KJV

[43] And when he thus had spoken, he cried with a loud voice, **Lazarus, come forth**. [44] **And he that was dead came forth**, bound hand and foot with graveclothes: and his face was bound about with a napkin. Jesus saith unto them, Loose him, and let him go.

“Many are still tested as was Abraham. They do not hear the voice of God speaking directly from the heavens, **but He calls them by the teachings of His word and the events of His providence**. They may be required to abandon a career that promises wealth and honor, to leave congenial and profitable associations and separate from kindred, to enter upon what appears to be only a **path of self-denial**, hardship, and sacrifice. Luke 24:19-27 KJV

[19] And he said unto them, What things? And they said unto him, Concerning Jesus of Nazareth, which was a prophet **mighty in deed and word before God and all the people:** [20] And how the chief priests and our rulers delivered him to be condemned to death, and have crucified him. [21] But we trusted that it had been he which should have redeemed Israel: and beside all this, to day is the third day since these things were done. [22] Yea, and certain women also of our company made us astonished, which were early at the sepulchre; [23] And when they found not his body, they came, saying, that they had also seen a vision of angels, which said that he was alive. [24] And certain of them which were with us went to the sepulchre, and found it even so as the women had said: but him they saw not. House Of Israel

Ezekiel 37:3-8 KJV

[3] And he said unto me, Son of man, can these bones live? And I answered, O Lord God, thou knowest. [4] Again he said unto me, **Prophecy upon these bones, and say unto them, O ye dry bones, hear the word of the Lord.** [5] Thus saith the Lord God unto these bones; Behold, **I will cause breath to enter into you, and ye shall live:** [6] **And I will lay sinews upon you, and will bring up flesh upon you, and cover you with skin, and put breath in you, and ye shall live; and ye shall know that I am the Lord.** [7] **So I prophesied as I was commanded: and as I prophesied, there was a noise, and behold a shaking, and the bones came together, bone to his bone.** [8] And when I beheld, lo, the sinews and the flesh came up upon them, and the skin covered them above: but there was no breath in them.

Four Winds-The World

Ezekiel 37:9-14 KJV

[9] Then said he unto me, Prophecy unto the wind, prophecy, son of man, and say to the wind, Thus saith the Lord God; Come from the four winds, O breath, and breathe upon these slain, that they may live. [10] So I prophesied as he commanded me, and the breath came into them, and they lived, and stood up upon their feet, an exceeding great army. [11] Then he said unto me, Son of man, these bones are the whole house of Israel: behold, they say, Our bones are dried, and our hope is lost: we are cut off for our parts. [12] Therefore prophecy and say unto them, Thus saith the Lord God ; Behold, O my people, I will open your graves, and cause you to come up out of your graves, and bring you into the land of Israel. [13] And ye shall know that I am the Lord, when I have opened your graves, O my people, and brought you up out of your graves, [14] And shall put my spirit in you, and ye shall live, and I shall place you in your own land: then shall ye know that I the Lord have spoken it, and performed it, saith the Lord.
