




Fundraiser Recommended for All Ages

Students engage in a fundraiser campaign to supplement funds used by Speak Up for Kids to aid and assist supplemental needs for children in foster care in Palm Beach County. These funds may be used for non-traditional therapy, special glasses, lessons, instruments, special suits or clothing needed for special events, or needs that arise that may be extra and above ordinary care opportunities.

1. Getting Started

- Decide on an amount you'd like to raise. NOTE: Let us know and your group or family are working towards a special cause. We can help you specialize the fundraiser.
- Familiarize yourself with our <u>donation link</u>, which can be <u>found on the top right of our page</u>. You'll want to encourage your donors to select "STUDENTS Speak Up for Kids" from the dropdown menu "Apply My Donation to".



 Create a flyer or graphics that will publicize this link and contain instructions for donors.





- Keep the mission in mind while posting information or creating flyers for the event.
- Share about the good your fundraiser will do and the support it brings.

2. Launching Your Project

If this is your FIRST PROJECT with STUDENTS Speak Up for Kids: Sign up on the website (2 steps):

- Click "Let's Get Started" (fill out the form) and choose your grade level. (Many have completed this portion.)
- On the next page, click "Submit Idea". If you already completed the step above scroll to the bottom and click your grade level)
- If this is a REPEAT PROJECT with STUDENTS Speak Up for Kids: You are
 already in our system, and you'll only need to "Complete one step and use the
 BONUS Repeat the Fun" link to sign up your project. (Found on the grade level
 page at the bottom of our website last step).

3. After Your Project

- Anyone can take part and administer any of these service projects. To receive community service hours for your time, please follow these five simple steps:
- 1. Complete the "Launching Your Project" steps from above.
- 2. Track your hours for learning, planning, launching, social media time, etc.
- Take pictures of the donors, students working on the project, the posts that are used to share about the project. Email any pictures to <u>STUDENTS@SpeakUpForKidsPBC.org</u>
- 4. Post your pictures and share your project on Social Media by using #StudentsSpeakUpForKidsPBC.





5. After your project is complete, return to our website and <u>Submit Project Hours</u> and upload your hours.
