
ILLUSIONS OF DEPTH

LAYER-ART IN ILLUSTRATOR

Here's an Overview of the Layer-art Process in Illustrator.

- 1. Create a new Illustrator document.
- 2. Create a shape to cut out of the piece of paper.
- 3. Create a piece of paper.
- 4. Cut it out.
- 5. Add another piece of paper, either by duplicating the previous one, or by creating a new one.
- 6. Lock the previous layer.
- 7. Change the new piece of paper's colour to be darker if it's lower down or lighter if it's higher up.
- 8. Manipulate the new layer.
- 9. Repeat steps 2-7 until you have a nice layered effect.
- 10. Once all your pieces of paper are cutout and layered, change their fill colour to white, and add a drop shadow.
- 11. Then lock all the layers again, except for the one you're currently tweaking.
- 12. Change the colours of your layers.
- 13. Tweak tweak tweak.
- 14. Share!
